Bus transport to the Hospital

From Swindon Town centre you can either use the number 16 Thamesdown shuttle bus or the number 8 Stagecoach bus (towards Chiseldon) from the bus station (stand 5). The bus station and Fleming Way are both sign posted from the train station.

The 16 runs directly to and from the GWH every 10 minutes during weekdays 08:00 to 18:00. It then runs every 15 minutes during from 18:00 until 22:00 and every 30 minutes at weekends. The fare is £2.00 and you will need the exact change.

The 8 runs every 20 minutes during weekdays and Saturdays, it does not run to the hospital on Sundays. A single fare is £2.00 however you do not need the exact change.

By rail

The nearest main line station is Swindon station located in the town centre. For train timetables, you can visit the <u>National Rail website</u> or tel: 08457 48 49 50.

By cycle:

The hospital is linked to the Swindon cycle path network. Cycle parking is available and is marked on the site map.

By road:

The hospital is located to the southeast of Swindon town centre, close to Junction 15 of the M4 motorway. The hospital post code is SN3 6BB View the map.

From the M4:

Exit at Junction 15 and follow signs to Swindon. At the Common head roundabout take the first exit left into Marlborough Road A4259. The entrance to the Hospital is 300 metres on the left.

From the North:

On approaching Swindon, join the A419 south following signs for the M4. This is the Stratton St Margaret by-pass. Take the fourth exit right at the Commonhead roundabout into Marlborough Road A4259. The entrance to the Hospital is 300 metres on the left.

From the Town centre:

Leave the town centre via Fleming Way to the Magic Roundabout and travel straight across into Queens Drive A4259. At the next roundabout take the third exit to remain on Queens Drive. Travel straight ahead at the next roundabout into Marlborough Road. The entrance to the hospital is 1500 metres on the right.

Car parking

Parking charges are pay on exit. Lost or damaged cards will be charged at the 6-24 hours rate. Pay machines accept coins or cards.



The Academy is situated on the lower ground floor at the rear of the main hospital building. Located between the Brunel Treatment Centre entrance, Carillion entrance and across the road from the Victoria Centre and SWICC Centre, it is sign posted. You can also gain access through the main hospital.
